## HIGHLIGHTS AROUND SNOWDONIA

22<sup>nd</sup> - 24<sup>th</sup> APRIL 2022

Enjoy the scenic drive through Dinas Mawddwy and the Snowdonia National Park to Porthmadog before arriving in coastal Criccieth for dinner. After breakfast, take a coastal steam train ride from Porthmadog to Caernarfon, a town with narrow streets, a stylishly redeveloped waterfront and the famous 13<sup>th</sup> century Caernarfon Castle (commanding the lion's share of attention). On route home, visit Portmeirion Village, well known as the film location for the 1960s cult TV series The Prisoner. Experience the magic of the Italian Riviera with the scenic backdrop of coastal Wales.
